

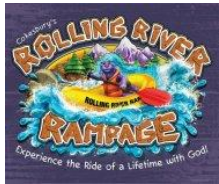

Since 2009, **Books for Keeps (BFK)** has given more than 260,000 books to children from low-income families in Georgia in grades Pre-K through 12. **BFK** has a great need for new or gently-used books for children and young adults in Pre-K through 12th grade. They accept books of any kind, for children or adults.
