It will be led by Dr. David Knauff and have two components. We will begin indoors exploring the biblical basis for caring for God's creation, and provide an opportunity for participants to share with others the things they are already doing (and plan to do) to be Christian stewards of God's gift of creation.

The outdoor part will be a tour of the UGArden facility. After the tour, we will discuss whether participants of this workshop would be interested in having a Church Community Garden at UGArden. UGArden personnel will work with us to schedule times for our people to plant, weed and harvest what we grow. They will also provide training if needed and also help to distribute food to those in need.
